Hello;

My various pieces have finally arrived.

I have connected the Flashcat to the TDS3FFT module's +5V, GND, SCL and SDA.

I get a message saying no I2C detected.

I have tried various combinations on the Protocol page to no avail. From what I have gleaned from the EEVBlog pages the IC inside is a 24C08. What should I be using for the other options on the I2C protocol page?

Also do I have to ground the A0 and A1 lines of the module? I have ensured that the SCL and SDA lines have pullups to +5V (Although I measure 2.7V on those pins)

Hey Ken,

I wish I could help, but I remember next to nothing about what I did. I'm sure it all made sense at the time!

I dug out my Flashcat and I can't imagine that I changed any of the wires around when I was done, so this is probably how I had things set up when I flashed the module.

This is the FCUSB2X (Classic Flashcat) with the SOIC-8 (narrow) I2C daughter board. I bought the daughter board in case I needed to flash a new IC. I soldered in some header pins to attach the jumpers to the Pomona clip.

You should be able to trace the colored jumpers to the contacts on the Pomona clip to see how it's connected to the circuit.

I don't remember any of the config stuff, but I don't think it was very difficult.

I did get it to work finally. It was much happier with 1.8K pullups (instead of 4.7K) and a working 24C02 EEPROM in the app module !@#\$%. Only needed Vcc, GND, SDA, SCL. as shown in your photos. I used some really nifty Tek logic clips for a scrapped logic analyzer....

I can send you some my notes after I write them up, just incase some other lost soul comes knocking on your door.....

Hi Gray;

Thanks! It is actually 600 Mhz, it was a TDS3014B. Did discover that the original firmware (3.26) it would only go to a TDS3054B, updated to 3.39, it would update to a TDS3064B. Checking it, it averages a bw of 690 Mhz.....

I'll definitely send you my notes...

Thanks for everything! Anything I can help you please let me know.
