1. General description

PNP low V_{CEsat} transistor, encapsulated in an ultra thin DFN2020D-3 (SOT1061D) leadless small Surface-Mounted Device (SMD) plastic package with medium power capability and visible and solderable side pads.

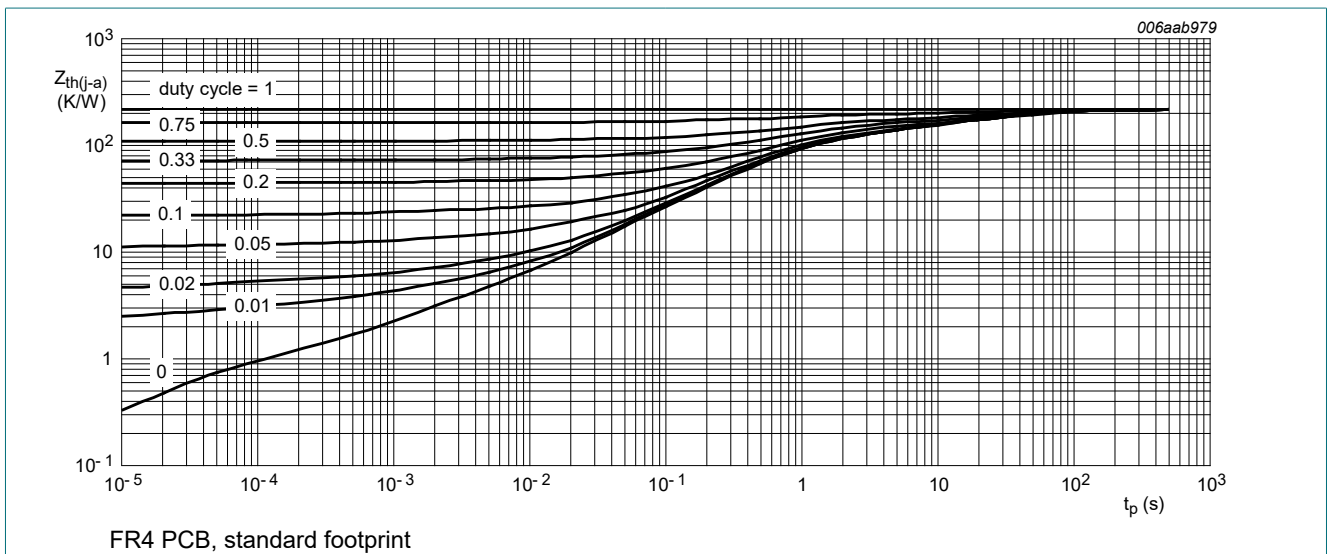


Fig. 2. Transient thermal impedance from junction to ambient as a function of pulse duration; typical values

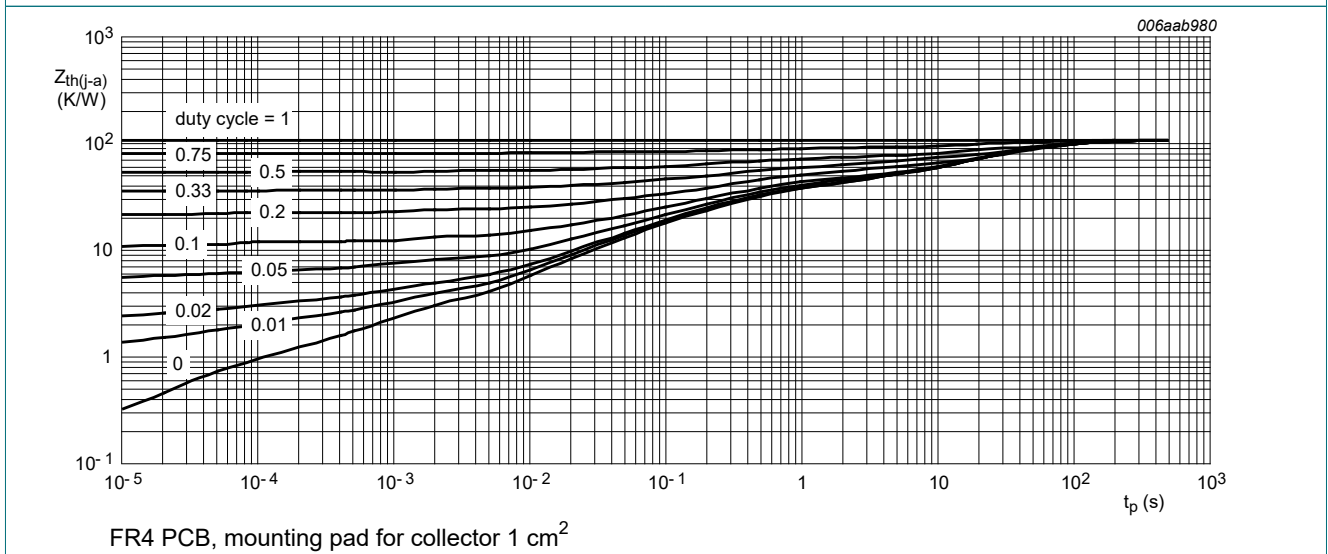


Fig. 3. Transient thermal impedance from junction to ambient as a function of pulse duration; typical values

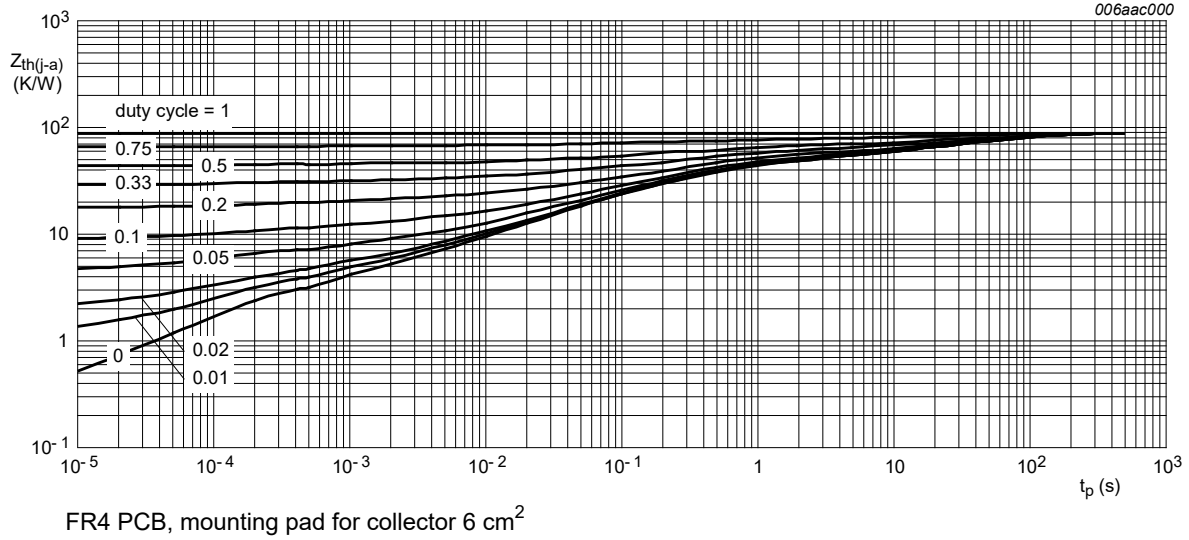


Fig. 4. Transient thermal impedance from junction to ambient as a function of pulse duration; typical values

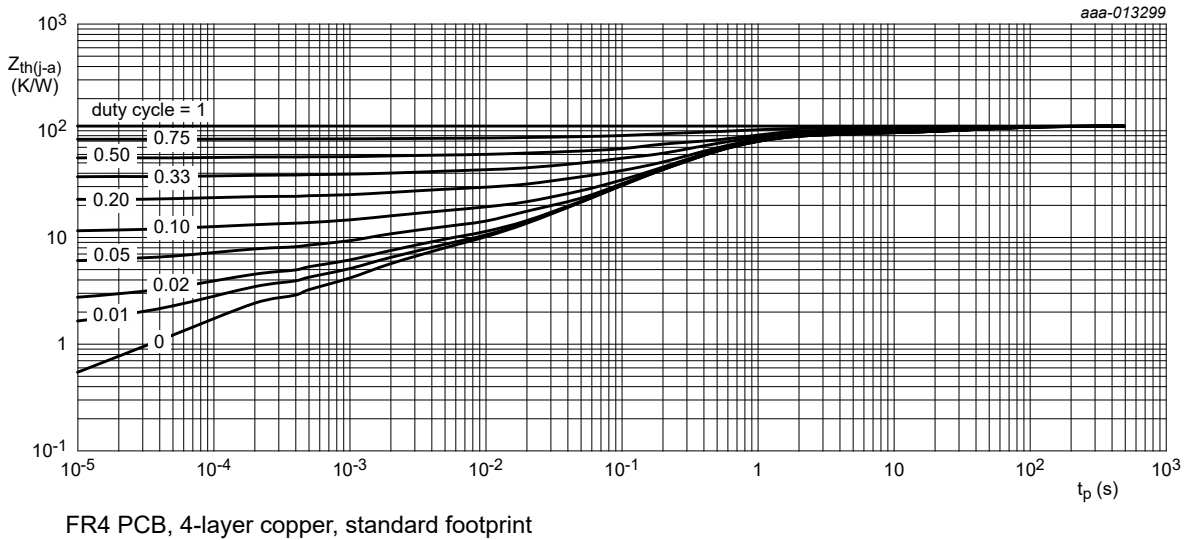


Fig. 5. Transient thermal impedance from junction to ambient as a function of pulse duration; typical values

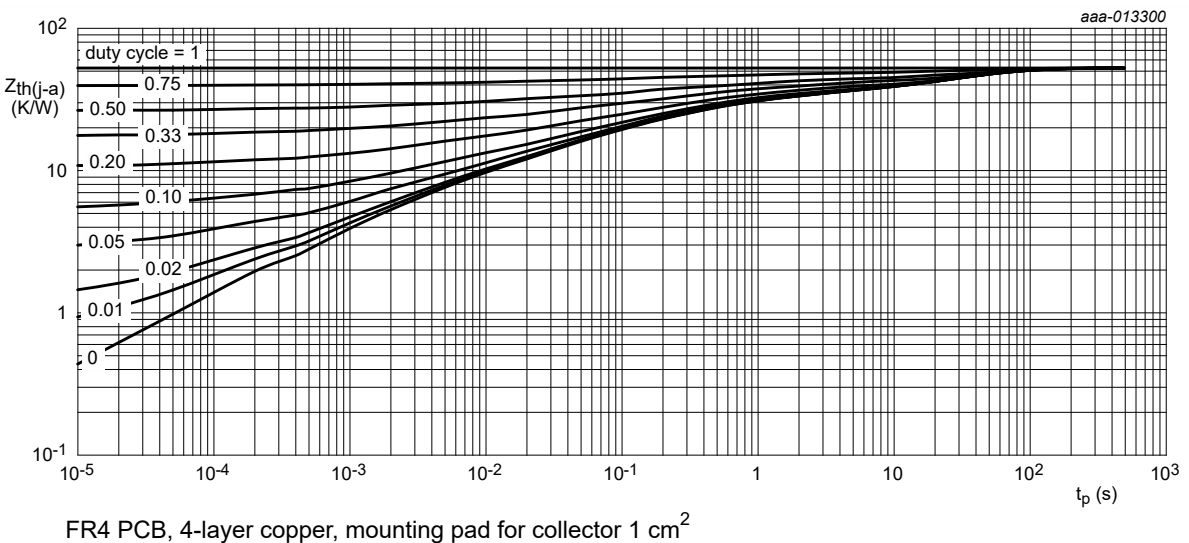
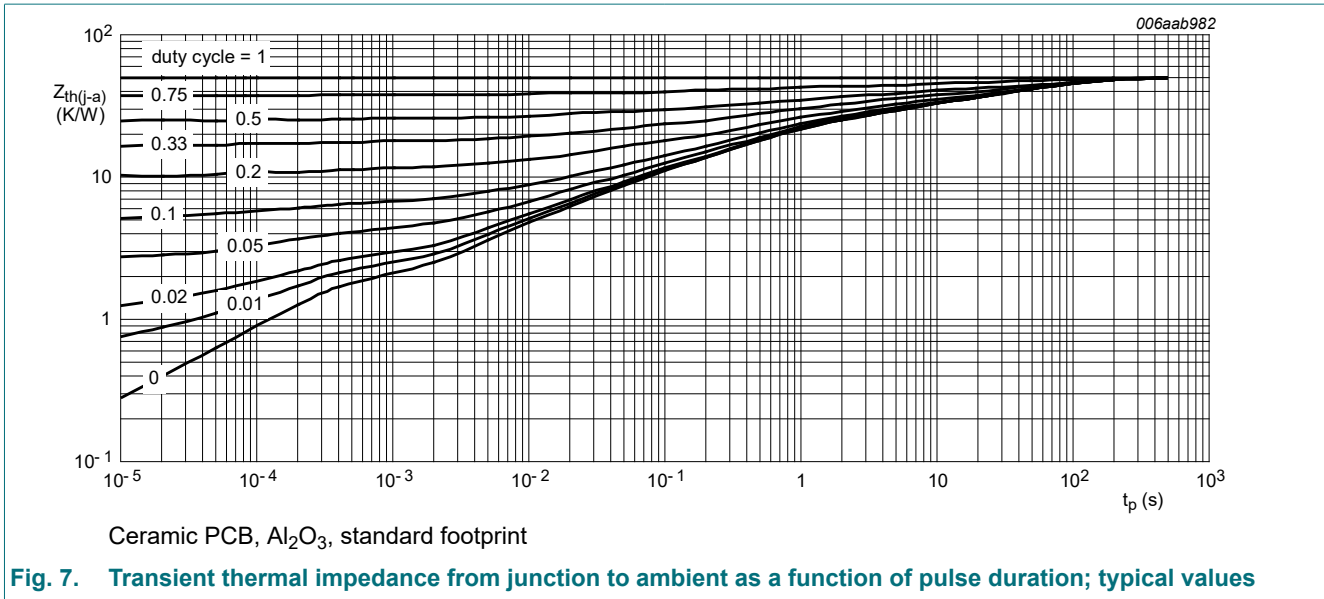


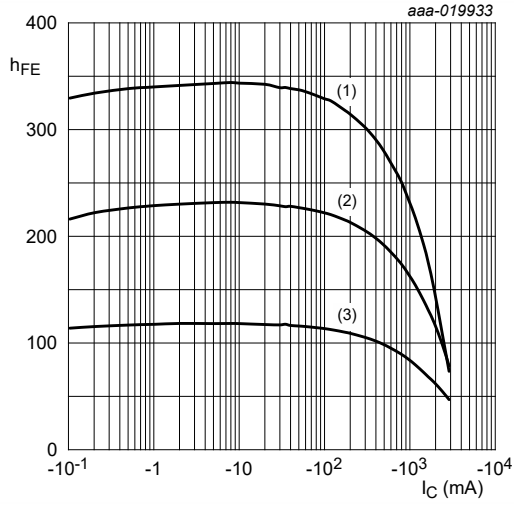
Fig. 6. Transient thermal impedance from junction to ambient as a function of pulse duration; typical values

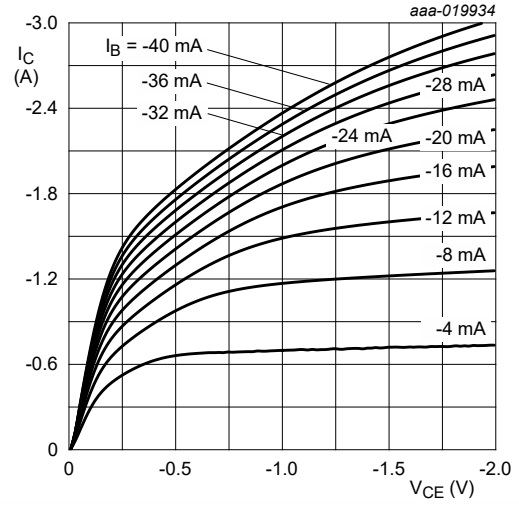

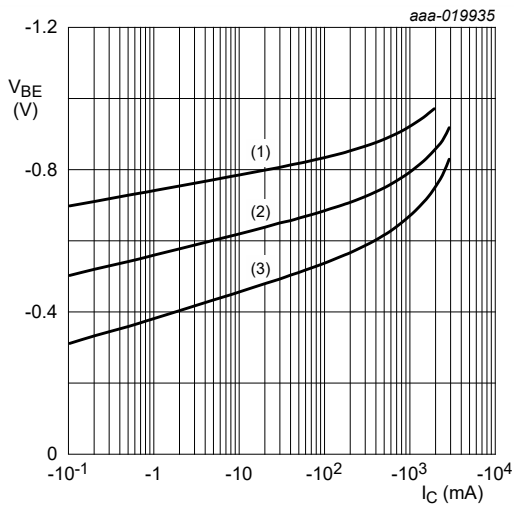

Fig. 8. DC current gain as a function of collector current; typical values



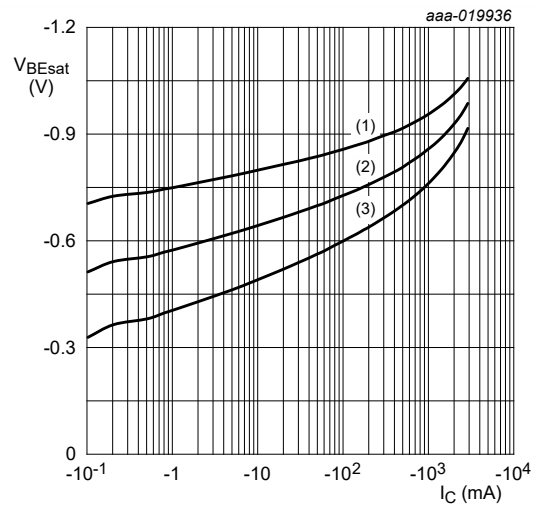

Fig. 9. Collector current as a function of collector-emitter voltage; typical values



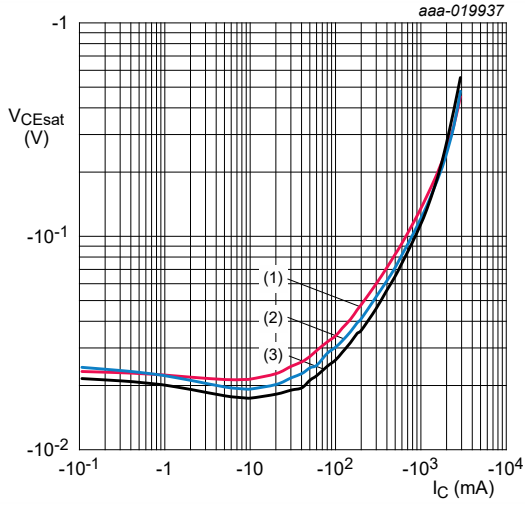

Fig. 10. Base-emitter voltage as a function of collector current; typical values



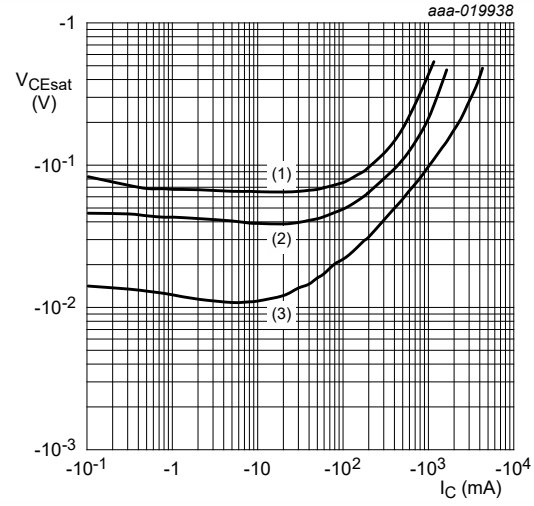

Fig. 11. Base-emitter saturation voltage as a function of collector current; typical values



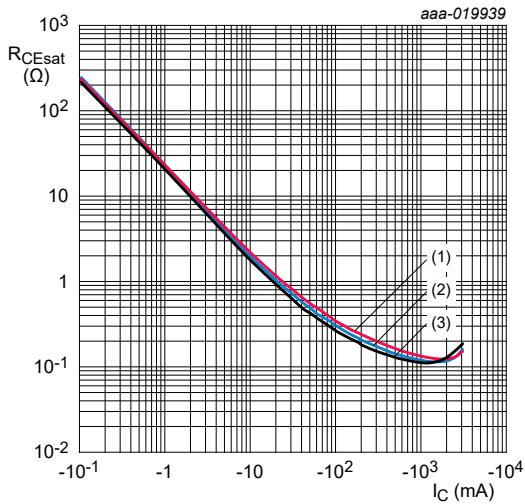

Fig. 12. Collector-emitter saturation voltage as a function of collector current; typical values



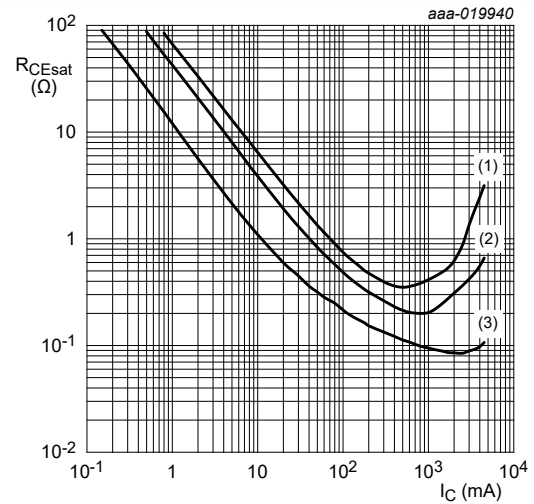

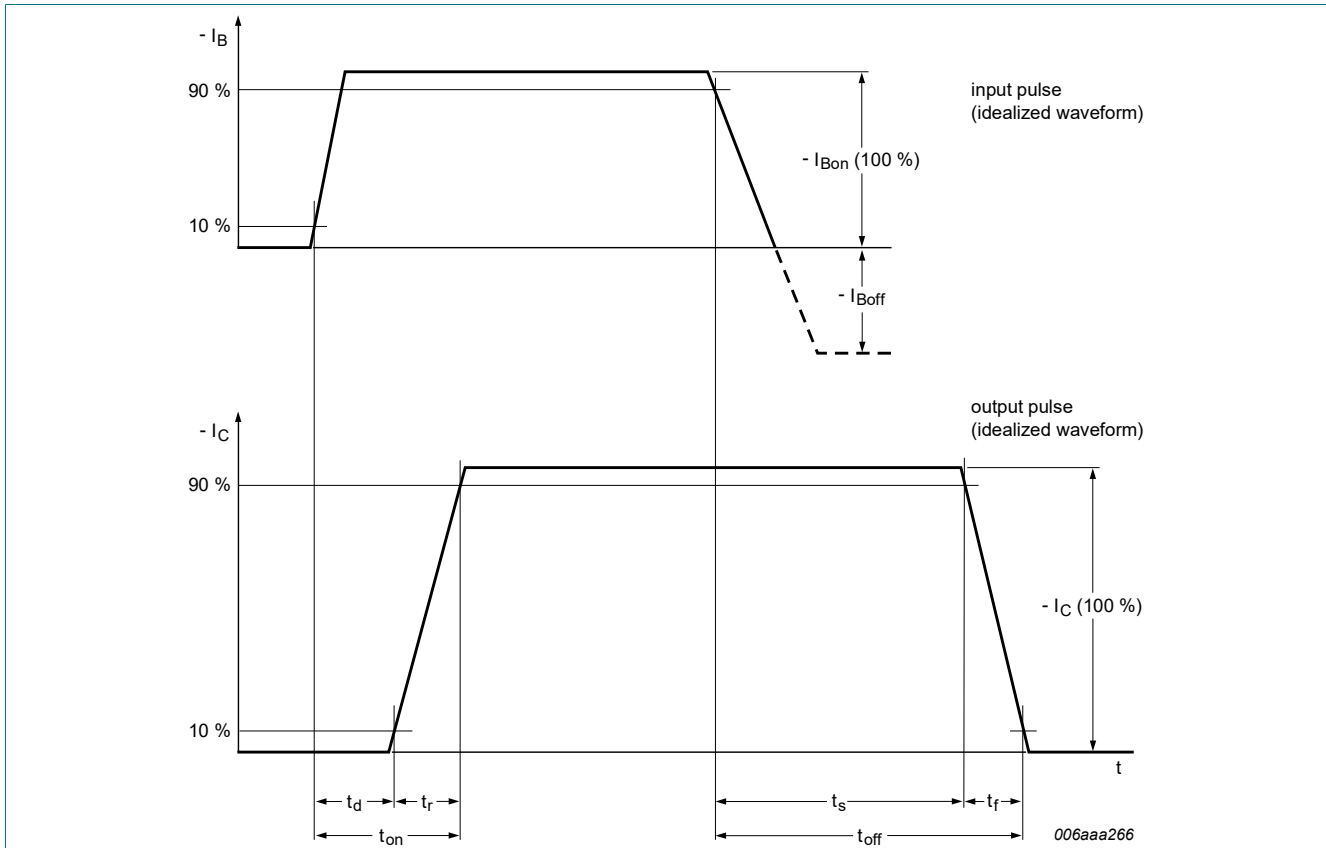


Fig. 16. BISS transistor switching time definition

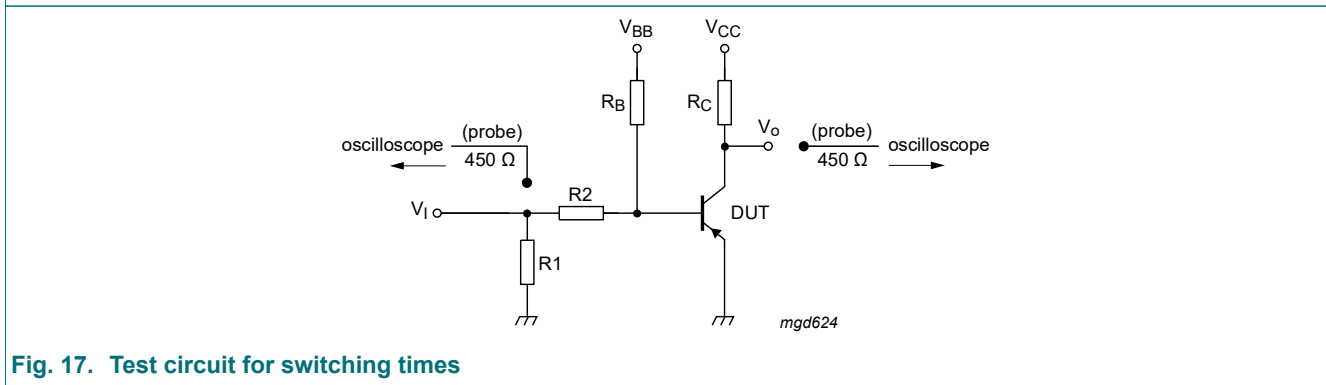
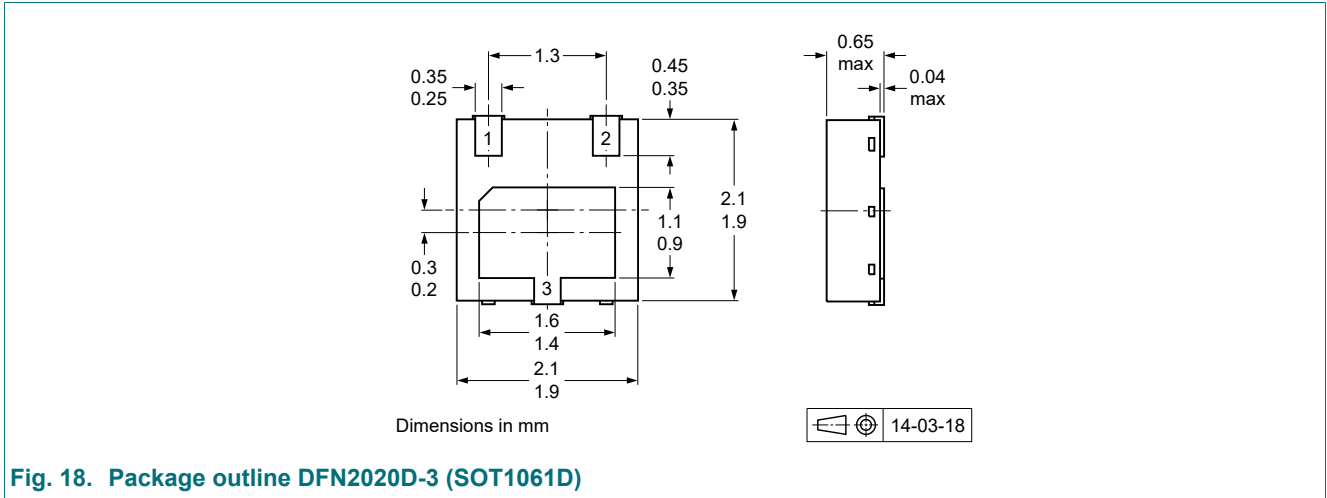


Fig. 17. Test circuit for switching times

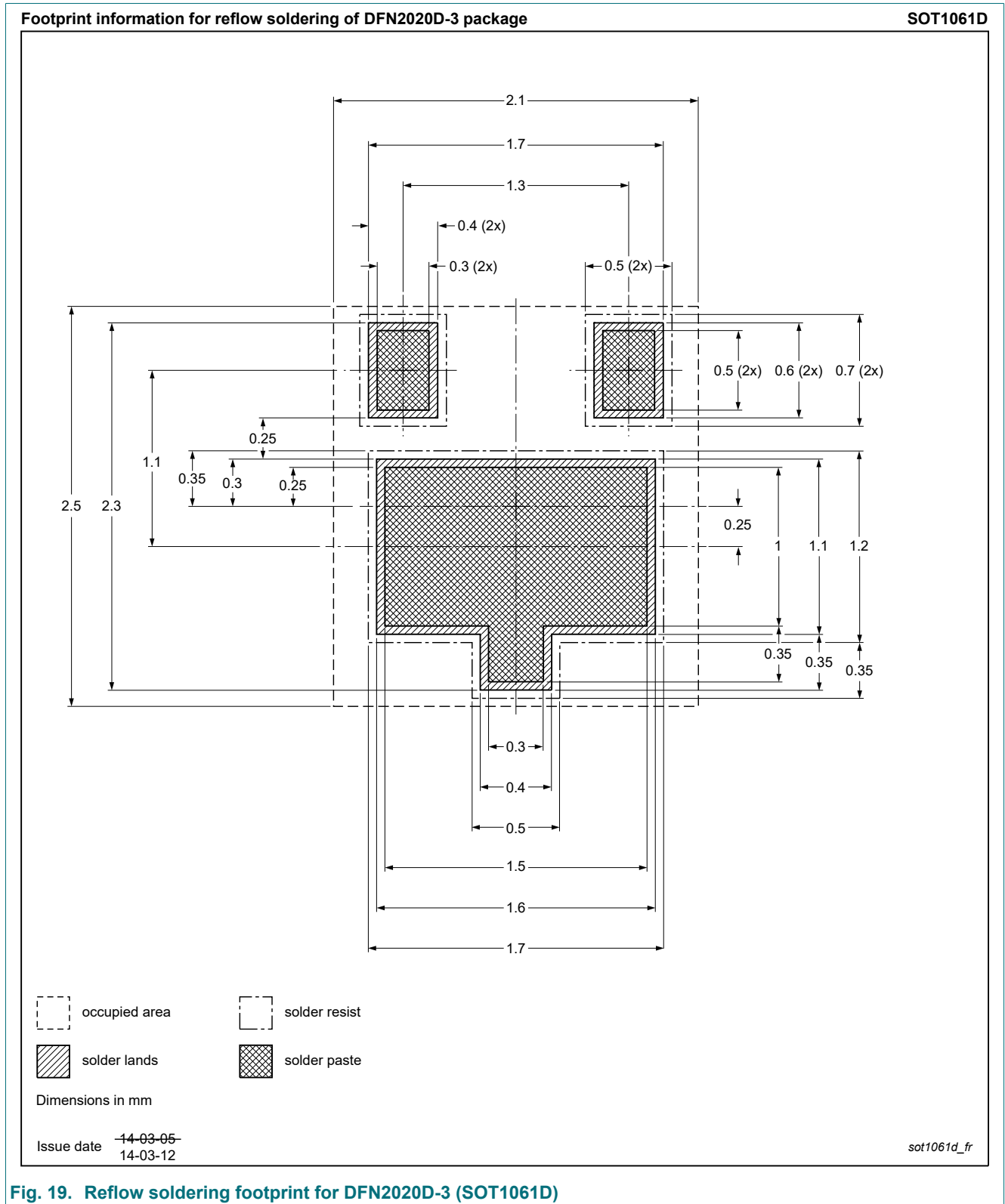


Fig. 19. Reflow soldering footprint for DFN2020D-3 (SOT1061D)
